What is HCC?

The goal of **hierarchical condition category (HCC)** documentation is to capture a patient's true clinical picture, including their disease severity and associated risk. HCC codes allow for scoring and classifying of at-risk members to help estimate costs for the next year of coverage.¹

Challenges For Health Systems

Health systems must capture accurate patient acuity to ensure appropriate reimbursement and avoid being financially penalized in risk-sharing arrangements.

Coding of chronic conditions needs to be re-captured at the start of each calendar year.

Inaccurate or missing HCC coding can result in loss of potential revenue as well as put health systems at risk in value-based contracts.

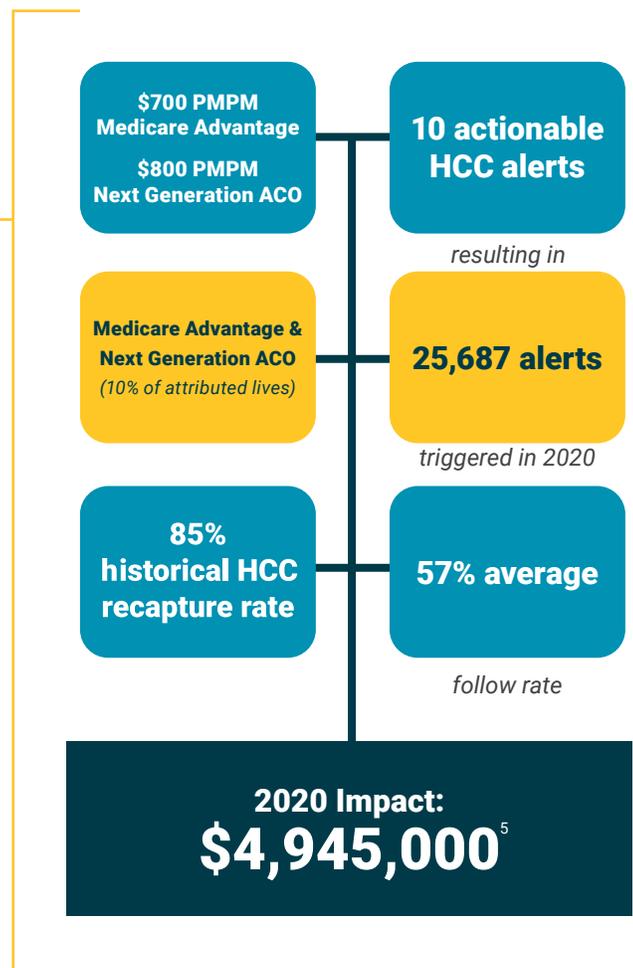
